

Armoury


Hi, I'm Tim Bissell, I have been fencing for ten years now and, for my sins, have been the club armourer for about two years. As armourer I repair the club's equipment when it stops working. As anyone who has been fencing more than a couple of months knows, the weapons take a battering in use, and can be temperamental.

If you encounter any problems with equipment which you cannot solve, then please let me (or one of the coaches) know. If you are not sure which bit of kit is playing up, then we will be able to help you track it down, replace it with spare equipment and get you back fencing. I will take the faulty kit home and fix it over the next week or so.

As well as servicing club equipment, I also offer a repair service for club members; if you have a problem with a piece of your own equipment and you don't feel confident fixing it, I will usually be able to repair it over the course of a week or two. The cost will be just the cost of any parts, plus a nominal labour charge, usually a pound or two, which goes into club funds and helps pay for new equipment. I can usually give an estimate straight away, so do feel free to ask - I am also happy to give advice if you want to have a go yourself.

In future articles I plan to cover topics such as how to trouble-shoot problems on the piste, common problems with weapons, maintenance tips and anything else I can think of. If you have any queries or topic suggestions, please let me know!

Coaching

Warming up

This is very important for all or us to stretch and warm-up our muscles, before throwing ourselves onto our opponents swords.

Try to get your own routine of warm up/stretching exercises so you do not have to thing "what shall I do"?

Start with some simple stretching exercises; Head/neck, Arms, Legs. Use the lunge position to stretch the legs, reverse it to LH lunge if you are RH and vice versa.

Warming up can be jogging – sprinting – jogging etc. slow – fast – slow, footwork with lunges.

Warming Up for Competition

This should follow your usual routine as above but must include a mental warm-up. As you warm-up try to start focusing on your fencing what did you coach say e.g. watch your distance, finger work/control of the point/blade, moves you have been practising etc. If possible have a warm-up fight but keep your mind focused on your game/tactics.


